<p>What content should be included in didactic sessions covering health economics, resource stewardship, care of patients with disabilities, the social determinants of health and care for vulnerable populations?</p> <p><i>[Program Requirements: IV.B.4. and IV.B.5.]</i></p>	<p>Programs should develop educational content in these areas that supports ophthalmology practice in their country or jurisdiction. For example, health economics can cover local health care costs, concepts of high-value care, or economic implications of diagnostic and treatment decisions. Education in the social determinants of health can cover topics related to health care for vulnerable and marginalized populations, including health care access and quality of care, health inequities and inequalities, and care planning with consideration of patients' social constraints.</p> <p>Content can be delivered in a variety of ways, including through didactic lectures, journal clubs, case presentations, and/or digital or web-based instruction. Sponsoring Institutions can also develop general educational sessions related to these topics that can be accessed by multiple residency and fellowship programs.</p>
